The wonderful thing about psychoanalytic thought is that it is an attitude that we can use to look at not only ourselves, but at the whole world as well. That is what makes psychoanalysis such a great field. There are so many areas to which we can apply analytic concepts.

It is this exploratory mindset and the connection to our mission that inspired CAPA's Special Lecture Series Program.

In addition to the traditional courses taught at CAPA, there is a wealth of other topics that we could not squeeze into the base curriculum and yet are still important to practitioners in China. So we first developed a Continuing Education Program in 2014 to create a home for these other exciting topics. The initial program audience was CAPA students and graduates, in an effort to provide continuing education opportunities on these diverse topics. The Continuing Education Program also gave faculty a chance to share their rich expertise and specialty areas with students, diving deeper into fascinating areas of thought and practice.

Member Interview

R. Mallory Starr, Ph.D.

R Mallory Starr, Ph. D. has been a CAPA member since 2010. He has contributed as a teacher and supervisor. His expertise as a consultant and friend of the organization has also helped CAPA in many ways over the years.

Where do you live and practice?

Chevy Chase, Maryland.



Retired from Clinical Psychology practice in 2000. Continuing as Director on some Boards and as a management consultant with Institute of Management Consultants USA. Consultant and Member of Institute of Management Consultants (imcusa.org).

Please describe your career path, including your educational development such as additional degrees or institutes you attended as you built your career.

Career Path continues. Path was from after undergraduate education management trainee at Chase Manhattan Bank and part-time on projects at J Walter Thompson Advertising Agency, Marketing Research Division. This was followed by graduate school education in clinical psychology, human development, and business. From 1965 – 68 Clinical Psychologist in Connecticut. 1968 to 1971 back in graduate school at doctorate level, teaching and research in human development. 1971 to 1994 clinical psychologist in clinic programs, private practice, and starting in the 1980s management consulting engagements. 1993 -2000 Partner in 2 consulting firms and some Board of Directors positions. 2001 Director of a distressed asset development group, some Board positions and private practice in executive consultation.

Who would you say is the person that influenced your career the most, and how so?

Herman Barry Molish, Ph.D. clinical psychologist and career officer in the US Navy. He was also engaged in many consulting psychology positions as part of the Navy and as a civilian. After more than 20 years retired from the Navy and became a director of a large psychiatric research center and became later Chief of Psychology at Baylor U Medical School in Houston, Texas. He was a mentor for me and colleague for over 20 years. As a result, I learned much and got many significant connections to the military, a few universities and other organizations, and individuals.

How did you first hear of CAPA, and please describe why you feel a connection to CAPA's mission?

Some history: as part of my early career as a clinical psychologist, staff member at mental health organization, consulting psychologist and in private practice I have met many psychoanalytically oriented and trained psychiatrists, psychologists, and social workers. When living in Connecticut in the 1960s I was a psychologist on staff at a child guidance center in Norwalk, Connecticut and Southeastern Child Guidance Clinic, New London, Connecticut as well as a research consultant at Norwich, Connecticut. On those days most practitioners were psychoanalytically oriented and many trained in psychoanalysis. Some were part of Yale University- as was Elise Snyder. In 2009 I spoke with Elise Snyder and mentioned some knowledge I had then of CAPA, and she encouraged me to join. My first experience in China was on a healthcare system study tour in 1983 -- there were 50 mostly American psychologists on this tour. At that time an estimate was that there may have been about 1,000 psychiatrists in China and plans were to increase that to more than 1 million. Some Chinese people we met said there were really no psychologists in China but some written materials and comments from some indicated that a few million mental health professionals would soon be trained, and licensing regulations were in development.

At times I wish I were a scholar but am not really. My work is focused on the application of knowledge and deals with getting alignment of groups to become teams to achieve objectives and goals. The theme of my work is to be a catalyst to internally strengthen an organization so that it can achieve greater success in the marketplace external to itself. With individuals, it is the same objectives and goals focus. For example, individuals have personalities which consist of 3 main functional parts which influence and drive behavior. Those parts are id which is biological drives and release of energy; ego which is sense of self and has several executive functions such as communication, interpersonal skills, such as empathy, concentration and attention, intelligence (reference if then systems) creativity, articulation and goal directedness, etc.; and superego — which is the values, the rules, education based socialization — being civilized. In simple terms. The interaction of the 3 parts — the id part has a wish to get something, the ego says to get it, but the superego says there are rules— social ways, laws and behavior guidance to follow as part of civilized society, and, these are important to consider before acting.

Even before I finished CAPA training, I started adult and child analytic training at PCOP. I expect to resume further contact with CAPA after my child analytic training is completed.


is there a CAPA member, perhaps a teacher or supervisor, that to this day stands out in your mind to have influenced you, encouraged you or supported you in an unexpected way?
